

STRIVE Future Leaders Program Youth Referral Form

STRIVE Future Leaders Program located in East Harlem at 240 E. 123rd St., provides wrap around services to court-involved youth by focusing on the development of life skills necessary for young adults to become self-sufficient adults. These services include case management services, family and educational support, career exploration, job readiness and life skills workshops, job placement, service learning activities, opportunities to earn industry-recognized credentials, legal support services, and six months of post-program follow-up services.

Youth must meet all of the following conditions to be eligible for STRIVE Future Leaders program services:

- ✓ ***Referral candidate must be at least 18 years and not older than 24 years of age***
- ✓ ***Currently involved or has been involved with the juvenile or adult justice system***
- ✓ ***Is currently residing in (or before confinement in a correctional facility resided in) the community to be served; and***
- ✓ ***Has never been convicted of a sex crime other than prostitution***
